STUDENT ART FOR ANIMALS CONTEST GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

Please review and follow contest guidelines carefully:

- All entries must be original. Computer-generated images and traced images will not be judged.
- Artwork is to be submitted to Miami-Dade Animal Services Department, 3599 NW 79 Avenue, Doral, FL 33122 no later than January 10, 2018. Late entries will not be judged.
- Artists must be in grades K through 12 during the 2017-2018 school year.
- Medium: Artwork done in crayon, ink, acrylics, oil paint, pastels, water color, colored pencils, Scratchboard, color marker, chalk, pastels, charcoal, paper collages, or photography are all acceptable. Three-dimensional work will be accepted. **PLEASE NOTE:** Pastels or charcoal entries **must** be properly sprayed to prevent smearing.
- Only **one** entry per student permitted.
- Follow copyright laws. Acknowledgement and credit must be placed on the entry form for any published piece by which the student has gained inspiration.
- All submitted work **must** measure no larger than 12" x 19" and may be horizontal or vertical.
